**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE EMPLOYMENT POSITION
OF CONSTRUCTION OBSERVER**

*BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SOUTH SANGAMON WATER COMMISSION, SANGAMON
COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:*

SECTION 1: The employment position of Construction Observer is hereby
created. The Construction Observer shall be supervised by the Construction Manager and shall:

a. provide observation and inspection of the construction of Commission
capital projects, including but not limited to the water plant and well field and finished water
mains and raw water mains, on days and at times and places designated by the Construction
Manager;

b. perform other duties reasonably related to the foregoing, as assigned by the
Construction Manager.

SECTION 2: The Construction Observer shall be paid \$ 55.00 per hour,
plus time and a half for hours exceeding 40 hours per week, plus out of pocket expenses,
including but not limited to cell phone and mileage.


SECTION 3: The Construction Observer shall serve at the pleasure of the
