Ordinance No. 14-01

AN ORDINANCE CREATING EMPLOYMENT POSITIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SOUTH SANGAMON WATER COMMISSION, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: There is hereby created the part time employment position of Parttime Plant Operator. The Part-time Plant Operator shall perform such duties as are required by the General Manager from time to time, including but not limited to making required checks and taking required samples on weekends and at other times as directed by the General Manager.

SECTION 2: The General Manager may hire up to four Part-time Plant Operators. The Part-time Plant Operators shall be paid twice per month at a flat rate of \$75.00 per plant visit. They shall be considered employees and not independent contractors of the Commission.

SECTION 3: The Commission Clerk, who heretofore has been an independent contractor, shall henceforth be considered an employee of the Commission and paid as such at \$30.00 per hour.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is effective immediately and shall be effective as to all work performed by the Part-time Plant Operators and the Clerk commencing January 1, 2014.
