Resolution No. 19-04

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING OPERATING ACCOUNT FUND BALANCE POLICY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SOUTH SANGAMON WATER COMMISSION, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Purpose: The Commission's Operating Account will be managed so as to maintain balance at levels sufficient to mitigate current and future risks, such as revenue shortfalls and unanticipated expenditures, avoid cash flow interruptions, cover unforeseen catastrophes, and protect the Commission's credit worthiness.

This policy shall specify the size and compositions of the Commission's Operating Account and certain requirements for the same.

SECTION 2. Minimum Cash Balance: In order to provide liquidity adequate to address unexpected revenue reductions or unanticipated expenditures, the Operating Account will be managed by the Commission and/or the Commission's designee in such a way as to maintain a minimum cash balance of at least 10% of the budgeted annual expenditures on the last day of each fiscal quarter.

SECTION 3. Authorization and Review: This policy shall be placed in effect through the passage of a Resolution by the Commission. This policy shall be reviewed and modified as necessary depending upon the fiscal desires of the Commission.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is effective immediately.
